### Living in Chicago

Northeastern University has leased housing in Chicago, IL through Tailor Lofts, a student housing organization that offers off campus apartments for students at local universities such as Rush University and the University of Illinois at Chicago. Northeastern University leases two fully furnished apartments from Tailor Lofts and offers short-term housing for students on co-op in Chicago. Reservations, payment, preparation, move-in, and move-out procedures are coordinated by Northeastern University's Off Campus Housing and Support Services office, but you are encouraged to visit [tailorlofts.info/tailor-lofts-chicago-il](http://tailorlofts.info/tailor-lofts-chicago-il) to learn more about the resources, accommodations, and amenities provided by Tailor Lofts.

### Location

Tailor Lofts is located within a 15 minute walk to the Blue line, Orange line, and Pink line, with several bus routes nearby as well. There are a number of delicious restaurants and popular retail stores in the area, as well as several universities.

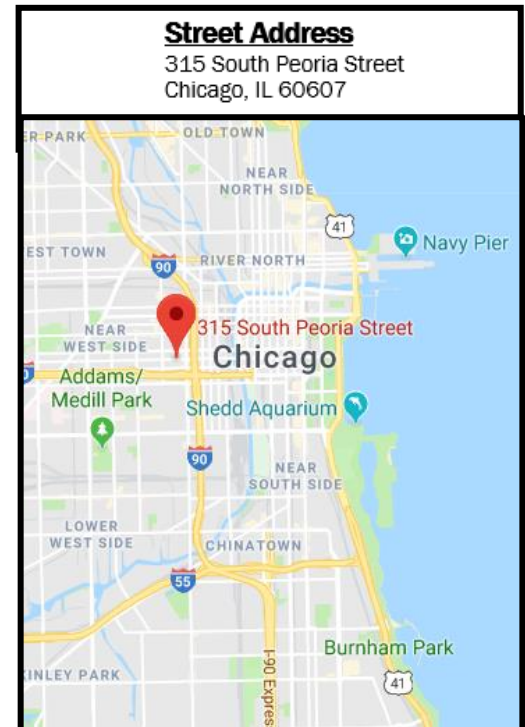
### Accommodations

Northeastern University has **8 single rooms available** in Chicago within two fully furnished apartments, and each apartment has 4 bedrooms and 4 bathrooms either directly attached to or nearby the bedroom. All rooms are available on a first come, first served basis. Each apartment includes a kitchen and sitting room (with a television), and each bedroom includes a **full-size bed, desk, chair, two stackable storage chests, and a closet**. Apartments may be mixed-gender, but every student will have their own bedroom and bathroom, with shared common spaces (kitchen and living room).

### Amenities

The Tailor Lofts' rate includes the following:

- All utilities: heating, cooling, electricity, internet, and cable
- Full kitchen, including a refrigerator, microwave, stove, oven, dishwasher, garbage disposal, and several small appliances
- 24-hour fitness center
- Mail and package services
- Card-operated laundry facilities in the building
- Trash chutes and recycling on every floor
- 24-hour main-entry security desk and surveillance
- Study rooms, conference rooms, a game room, a computer center, and complimentary printing

## Rates

The payment for the Chicago leased housing will be paid via Northeastern University's NUPAY and will appear on your student account, much like University Housing on campus. The rates for the 2020-2021 academic year are below:

Term	# of Weeks	Rate
Summer II 2020 (July and August)	9 weeks	\$2,223
Fall 2020 (September - December)	17 weeks	\$4,199
Spring 2021 (January - April)	17 weeks	\$4,199
Summer I 2021 (May and June)	9 weeks	\$2,223

Weekly Rate: \$247/week

## Securing Your Northeastern Leased Housing

To secure your leased housing in Chicago, you'll need to complete the following steps:

1. Finalize your co-op dates with your employer (i.e. the dates you'll need housing for your co-op).
2. Fill out the leased housing application at [northeastern.edu/offcampus/leased-housing-application/](http://northeastern.edu/offcampus/leased-housing-application/).
3. Submit a \$200 deposit for each term you intend to stay at the leased housing in Chicago. Follow the steps below:
  - a. Visit MyNortheastern.
  - b. Under "Services & Links" and "Student Financial Services," click on "Student Account, Payment and E-bill Information."
  - c. Click "Make a Payment through NUPAY."
  - d. Choose the appropriate housing deposit option based on your desired term(s) and location.

## Cancellation Policy

By applying and submitting your deposit, you are indicating that you intend to stay at and pay for the Chicago leased housing for all of the terms for which you deposited. However, we understand that plans can change. If you choose to no longer stay in the leased housing, **you must cancel in writing (via email to [offcampus@northeastern.edu](mailto:offcampus@northeastern.edu)) at least 45 days before the beginning of the term that you deposited for. For Summer II 2020, this date is May 15th, 2020. For Fall 2020, this date is July 15th, 2020.** Cancelling before these dates will ensure your deposit is refunded. If you cancel after this date, you will still be responsible for the full cost of the terms you deposited for.
